**We are inviting all young clients, both lesson and livery to join our saddle club which will be developed to run specific training sessions for the needs of the helper and young horse person, who is interested in learning about how to keep horses and ponies safely and to care for them as well as improving their riding and generally having fun !**

**In order to satisfy the health and safety legislation and to ensure the safety and well being of all our helpers, it is necessary that any child wanting to spend time on the yard in addition to their allotted lesson time must be a fully paid up member of our saddle club.**

**The annual subscription for the saddle club 2006 is £45 payable on commencement. This fee will cover administration and supervision of the child whilst at Busby Equitation Centre Ltd.**

### **Membership Criteria:**

- **Regular client at BEC**
- **Min age 8 years**
- **Attendance at a minimum of four of the Saddle club training sessions to be held during the year**
- **Adherence with the basic rules of the yard as laid out on the attached document.**

### **Benefits of membership**

- **Monthly training sessions – will be organised. These will be priced at the subsidised rate of £15 and will usually last 1½ - 2 hrs depending on the nature of the session.**
- **Supervised learning and development towards ABRS or BHS stable management and progressive riding tests, in addition to stable helper certification.**
- **10 % saddle club discount card for all shop purchases of equestrian clothing and kit (excludes tack shop purchases )**
- **Saddle club subsidised holiday “own a pony days”**
- **Allocated member of staff to supervise saddle club members**

## **Basic Rules of the Yard**

- **No running or shouting on the yard**
- **No entering of prohibited areas and no entering stables unless authorised**
- **No smoking**
- **No swearing**
- **No more than 2 people in a stable at any one time if a horse or pony is in the stable**
- **No feeding horses or carrying sweets or food around the stable block**
- **No jewellery to be worn or brought to the yard**
- **Suitable clothing and footwear to be worn**
- **Gloves to be worn when leading**
- **No pony to be taken to the field or out of its stable without the appropriate head collar and lead rope or bridle to ensure adequate and safe control**
- **No personal stereos, DVD players, mp3 or ipods to be worn whilst on the yard**
- **No chewing gum and no dropping litter in the yard or stable block**
- **Break times and lunch times to be advised by the yard supervisor on the day**
- **Instructions of the yard staff must be followed**
- **Report all incidents or accidents to staff**
- **Any problems to be reported to staff**

**We reserve the right to ask for any child who is misbehaving, acting dangerously or not following the rules of the yard to be taken home immediately.**
